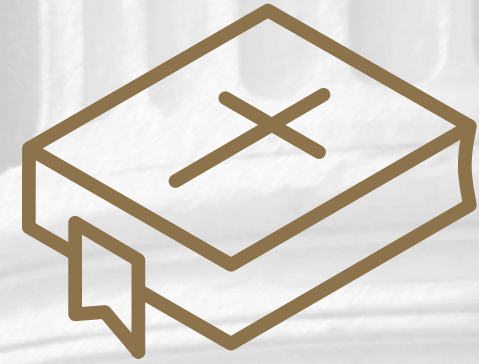




At CCS, we are passionate about building a strong foundation for the next generation of thinkers, leaders, and disciples through a classical Christian education.

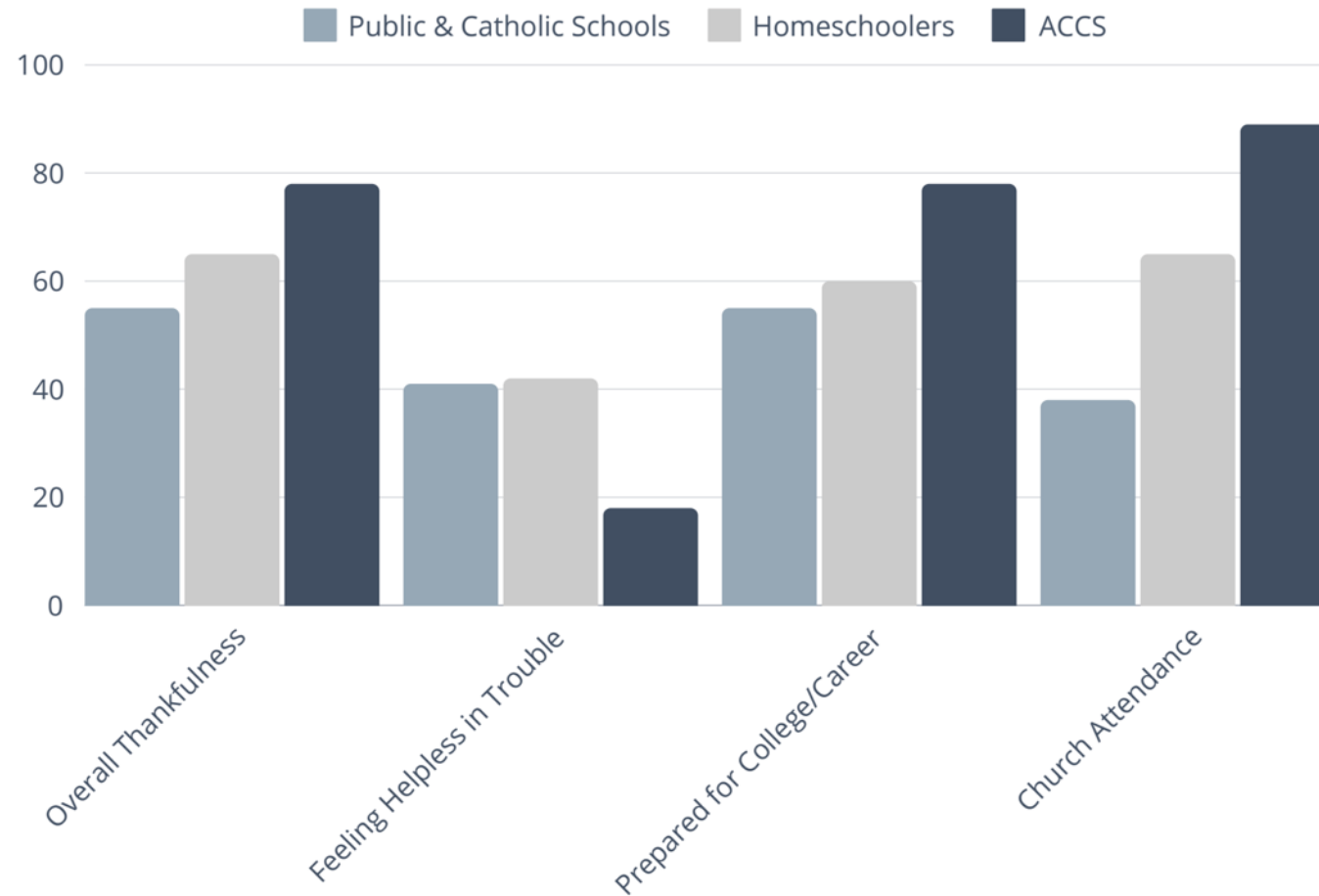


We equip students with the foundational tools to think deeply, reason critically, and live with integrity.

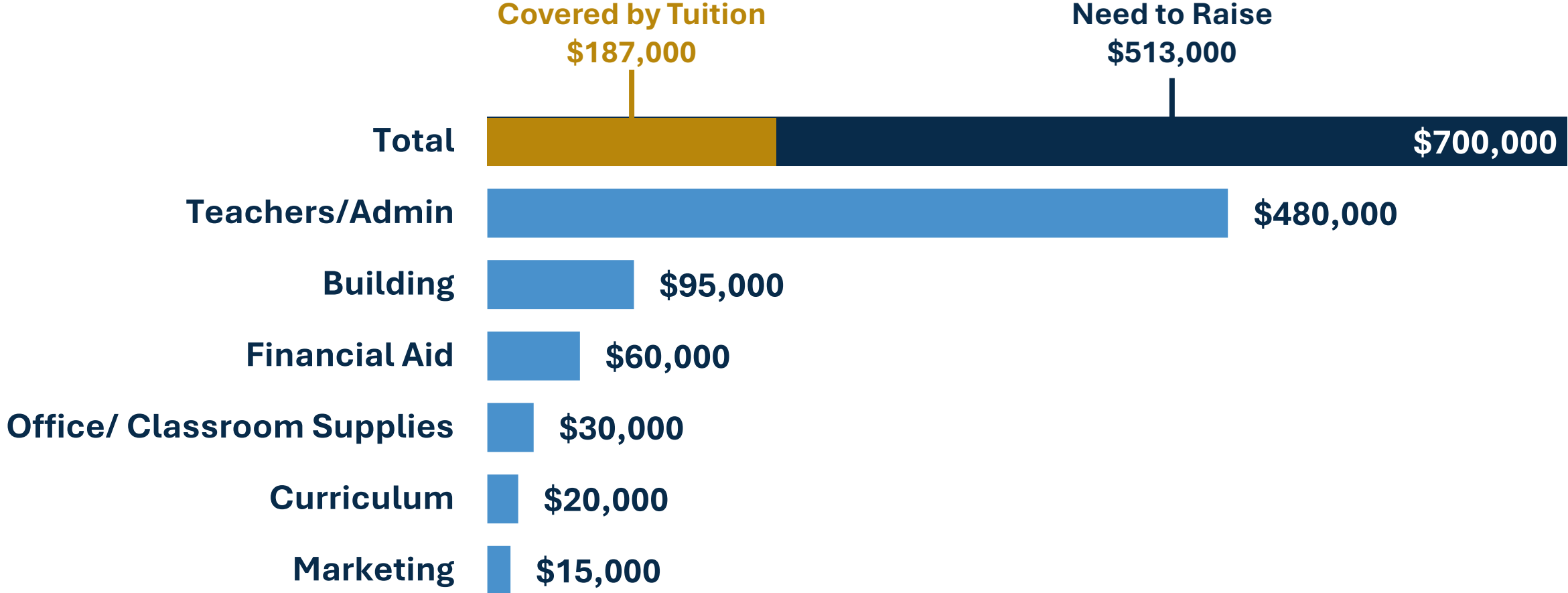
